The petitioner prays for bail pending trial in FIR No. 109 dated 05.07.2016 under Sections 302, 306, 34 IPC registered at Police Station City Rupnagar, District Rupnagar.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Samarjit Singh, informs that only two prosecution witnesses remain to be examined. They are the mother and the maternal uncle of the deceased.

Learned counsel for the complainant submits that the said witnesses undertake to be present before the learned trial Court on the next date of hearing i.e. 21.02.2018 for recording of their testimony.

In this view of the matter, I do not find any ground to afford the concession of bail pending trial to the petitioner at this stage.

Petition is, accordingly, dismissed.
