Petitioner has sought anticipatory bail under the provisions of Section 438 Cr.P.C. in case FIR No.195 dated 1.7.2018 under Sections 279, 336, 427 IPC and 13(1) of the Haryana Gauvansh Sanrakshan and Gausamvardhan Act, 2015, registered at Police Station Hathin, District Palwal,

2. Learned State counsel seeks further time to file reply. Having regard to the fact that the petitioner's status is only of owner of the truck and truck is stated to have been seized by the police. Therefore, the petitioner is entitled to anticipatory bail.

3. Petition is allowed. Petitioner is directed to appear before the Investigating Officer and join investigation as and when called by the Investigating Officer.

4. In the event of arrest, petitioner shall be released on interim bail subject to the satisfaction of the Arresting/Investigating Officer. Petitioner

shall join investigation as and when called upon to do so and he shall remain bound by the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

5. In addition to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C., the petitioner shall deposit a sum of ₹50,000/- in cash in the Court of Chief Justice Magistrate, Palwal.
