In the instant petition, petitioner has sought for quashing of the FIR No.101 dated 24.03.2018 under Sections 193/420/465/467 IPC, registered at Police Station Dharuhera, District Rewari (Annexure P-1).

2.) Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that arising out of motor vehicle accident, there is allegation relating to claim with reference to fake insurance policy etc. Decision against the MACT appeal is pending consideration. Merely pendency of MACT appeal that does not wipe out the allegations stated in the FIR. MACT would be with reference to the proceeding in the civil side. In other words, it is a civil litigation, whereas, allegations stated in FIR if the petitioner has produced fake insurance, in that event, the alleged allegation stated in FIR amounts to criminal offence. No material has been produced by the petitioner to establish in support of relief. Until the investigation is completed, it could not be said whether

there is prima facie case against the petitioner or not. Thus, petitioner has

not made out a case so as to interfere with the FIR.

3.) Accordingly, petition stands dismissed.
