In the instant petition, petitioner has sought for regular bail under the provision of Section 439 Cr.P.C. in case FIR No.68 dated 19.05.2018, under Section 420 IPC registered at Police Station Dharmkot, Distt. Moga.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that petitioner has been arrested on 11.01.2018. Challan and charge sheet has been furnished and completed and he is not involved in any other case.

3. On instructions of SI Rajinder Singh learned State counsel has also not disputed the above facts that petitioner is in custody since 11.01.2018 and he is not involved in any other case.

3. Heard the learned counsel for the parties.

4. In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner that he is not involved in any other case and disposal of the trial will take

sufficient time, I deem it appropriate to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

5. Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. Petitioner-Gurpreet Singh is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court/Duty Magistrate/Chief Judicial Magistrate concerned.

6. However, the petitioner shall not in any way indulge in any criminal activities and he shall also not influence the witnesses or other wise interfere with the fair trial.

7. Petition stands allowed.
