The present petition has been filed for quashing of FIR No.160 dated 15.11.2016 registered under Sections 451, 323, 506 and 34 of IPC at Police Station Machhiwara and all subsequent proceedings on the basis of compromise.

Vide order dated 20.09.2018, the parties were directed to get their statements recorded before the trial Court/ Illaqa Magistrate qua the genuineness of the compromise arrived at between the parties. The trial Court/ Illaqa Magistrate was directed to send the report to this Court qua the compromise after recording the statements of the parties.

Report has been received from Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Samrala wherein it is reported that the compromise arrived at by the petitioners is not genuine, voluntary and by free will of the parties. This observation of the Magistrate is based upon the statement made by the complainant that he has not effected any compromise with the accused and that the compromise placed on record on the file before the High Court is

not genuine.

In view of the above, I do not find any merit in the present petition and the same is dismissed.
