This is a second petition that has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.136 dated 03.08.2017 registered under Sections 376/354 of Indian Penal Code at Police Station Sadar, District Hoshiarpur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner herein contends that subsequently there is an affidavit that has been furnished by the Manager of the Hotel Mr. Aman Kumar Sharma, which is counter to the statement recorded under Section 161 Cr.P.C.

Notice of motion had been issued in the matter, pursuant to which appearance has been caused on behalf of the complainant as well as

the respondent-State. They submit that the petitioner has not been declared as a proclaimed offender, and therefore, he is not entitled to the concession of anticipatory bail.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

By a detailed order dated 25.04.2018 passed in CRM-M-44555-2017, anticipatory bail petition of the petitioner had been dismissed. No fresh grounds are made out to differ with the order so passed.
