The instant petition has been filed under Section 482 of Cr.P.C. seeking a direction to the respondents to take action against the accused persons in FIR No.142 dated 26.03.2018, under Sections 363, 366-A of Indian Penal Code and Sections 3 and 4 of the POCSO Act, registered at Police Station Sadar Jagraon, District Ludhiana.

It is contended that no legal proceedings have been initiated against the accused persons, despite registration of the aforesaid FIR. Learned counsel for the petitioner urges that the application dated 02.07.2018 (Annexure P-2) should be decided expeditiously.

Notice of motion to the respondents.

At this stage, on the asking of the court, Ms. Rajni Gupta, Senior DAG Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents-State and

submits that the respondents will look into the matter and will decide the application of the petitioner within a period of eight weeks, on receipt of certified copy of this order. Let sufficient number of copies of the paper book be supplied to her during the course of the day.

In view of the above, I dispose of the instant petition by directing the respondents-State to decide the application dated 02.07.2018 (Annexure P-2) of the petitioner within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order, in accordance with law.

The petition stands disposed of in the above-said terms.
