The petitioner prays for issuance of appropriate directions to respondents No.1 and 2 to protect his life and liberty and that of his family members as the same has been allegedly threatened by respondents No. 4 to 6.

2. The allegations of the petitioner is that a sum of Rs.3,50,000/- was taken by respondent No.4 on the pretext of providing the petitioner a job in the respondent-Department. However, neither the job has been provided nor the money has been refunded. The cheque for a sum of Rs.3,50,000/- has been issued but the same has been dishonoured. Thereafter, a representation dated 25.07.2018 (Annexure P-1) has been submitted before respondent No.2 but no action has been taken thereupon.

3. Notice of motion to respondents No. 1 to 3 only.

4. Mr. R.S. Bains, DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.,1 to 3. Let four copies of the complete paperbook be supplied to him during the

course of the day.

5. The petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to objectively consider the representation dated 25.07.2018 (Annexure P-1) and take appropriate action in accordance with law within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

6. It shall be ensured that no harm comes to the petitioner as well as his family members.
