By this petition, FIR No.44 dated 02.05.2015, registered against the petitioner at Police Station Singh Bhagwantpur, District Rupnagar, for the alleged commission of offences punishable under Sections 341, 324, 323, 506, 427, 34 IPC, is sought to be quashed, on the basis of a compromise arrived at between the petitioner-accused and respondents no. 2 & 3, i.e. the complainant and injured.

Pursuant to the order dated 22.10.2016, the report of the learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Rupnagar, has been received, stating therein that the statements of the petitioner and complainants, i.e. respondent no.2 & 3 Kamla Devi and Rajinder Kumar, were recorded, which have been sent along with report, stating that they have entered into compromise with their free will, without any pressure and coercion.

Keeping in view the nature of the offences and the fact that the

parties have compromised the matter with each other, with the complainant and injured no longer wishing to pursue criminal proceedings, in the opinion of this Court, it would be pointless to continue with such proceedings.

Consequently, the petition is allowed and FIR No.44 dated 02.05.2015, registered against the petitioner at Police Station Singh Bhagwantpur, District Rupnagar, for the alleged commission of offences punishable under Sections 341, 324, 323, 506, 427/34 IPC, along with all proceedings arising therefrom, is hereby quashed.
