Prayer in this petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.116 dated 06.08.2016 under Sections 304-A, 34 IPC (the offence punishable under Section 306 IPC was added later on), registered at Police Station Sadar Sangrur, District Sangrur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that during the pendency of the present petition, matter has been compromised between the parties vide agreement/compromise dated 06.07.2018 (Annexure P-3) and a separate petition i.e. CRM-M-30293-2018 titled as “Gurpreet Kaur and another Versus State of Punjab and another” for quashing of FIR on the basis of compromise has been filed, which is pending before this Court and is now fixed for hearing on 28.09.2018. He further states that the petitioner

has been falsely implicated and trial in the case may take long time.

Learned State counsel on instructions from the Investigating Officer does not dispute the custody period of the petitioner.

Having heard learned counsel for the parties and considering the fact that the petitioner is in custody since long, coupled with the fact that trial in the case may take long time, I deem it appropriate to release him on regular bail.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed and the petitioner is admitted on regular bail, subject to furnishing of his bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
