ARVIND SINGH SANGWAN, J.(ORAL) :

Prayer in this petition is for issuance of a direction to respondent No.2 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner at the hands of respondent No.3.

Reply by way of affidavit of Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division Patti, District Tarn Taran, on behalf of respondents No.1 to 4 has been filed in the Court and the same is taken on record.

As per reply, it is stated that an inquiry was conducted by Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division Patti, District Tarn Taran, regarding application dated 19.04.2018 submitted by Nishan Singh and another i.e respondents No.5 and 6, regarding the dispute of mortgaging the land measuring 72 kanals and 14 marlas. The concluding part of the inquiry reads as under:

“Report is being sent to your goodself and it is

requested that if the enquiry report is approved the legal opinion from D.A.(Legal) Tarn Taran may be obtained and on receipt of legal opinion the directions may be issued to SHO, P.S.Sadar Patti to get register a criminal case under the appropriate provisions of law against Daljit Singh aforesaid.”

In view of the same, since the inquiry officer has submitted that the petitioner was called upon by the police only to join the inquiry proceedings and there is no threat to his life and liberty, this petition is rendered infructuous, with liberty to the petitioner to file a fresh petition, if so required.
