Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 is for setting aside the order dated 16.07.2018 (Annexure P-6) passed by learned Sessions Judge, Karnal, whereby on a petition filed by respondents no.4 and 5, protection was granted to them.

This Court has perused the aforesaid order dated 16.07.2018 and finds that there is no illegality in that order, so far as granting of protection to respondents no.4 and 5 is concerned. Moreover, learned Sessions Judge has already made it clear that he is not observing anything about the authenticity of the marriage. Therefore, this Court does not find any reason to interfere in the aforesaid order.

However, learned counsel for the petitioners has raised a plea that respondent no.5 is already married and he had made false averments in the petition filed before learned Sessions Judge and therefore, the petitioners have submitted a representation to Superintendent of Police, Karnal.

Without observing anything on the merits of claim of the petitioner, so projected, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent no.2 to look into the representation dated 18.07.2018 (Annexure P-7), so submitted by the petitioners and act in accordance with law.
