Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for issuance of a direction to respondents No. 2 not to call the petitioner to the police station repeatedly and to harass him as the petitioner is not involved in any criminal case and no FIR is pending against him.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and perused the paper book and am of the view that instead of making any representation to the authorities concerned, the petitioner has straight away approached this Court. Therefore, in the absence of any such representation, no direction can be issued.

The present petition is accordingly dismissed.

However, the petitioner is at liberty to approach the Superintendent of Police concerned for redressal of his grievances, if any.
