It is the contention of the learned counsel for the petitioner that initially an FIR was registered against the petitioner being FIR No. 93 dated 20.06.2015 (Annexure P-3) under Sections 447, 511 and 427 IPC, which, after investigation, was cancelled and thereafter, FIR No. 66 dated 10.07.2016 (Annexure P-4) under Sections 117, 193, 120-B, 419, 420, 427, 447, 465, 467, 468 and 471 IPC was registered at Police Station Punjab Agriculture University against respondent No. 5 to 9. After registration of the FIR, opinion of the District Attorney (Legal) Ludhiana was obtained, who, in his opinion dated 12.05.2016 (Annexure P-6), found that the said offences, under which the FIR was registered, were made out. Further clarification was given by him on 05.07.2016 (Annexure P-7), which reiterated his earlier opinion. Despite that, no further action has been taken

on the said FIR by the Investigating Agency. Petitioner has also approached the Police Commissioner, Ludhiana by way of a representation dated 13.03.2017 (Annexure P-8) but till date, nothing has been done by the Investigating Agency. Petitioner has also approached the DGP, Punjab, through a representation dated 15.05.2017 (Annexure P-9) but without any result.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner, at this stage, would be satisfied if a direction is issued to the Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana-respondent No. 3 to look into the representation of the petitioner dated 13.03.2017 (Annexure P-8) and take appropriate steps in accordance with law.

Without going into the merits of the case or commenting thereon, the present petition is disposed of with directions to the Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana-respondent No. 3 to look into the representation of the petitioner dated 13.03.2017 (Annexure P-8) and take appropriate steps, in accordance with law, including issuance of directions to the concerned officials, if required, for redressal of the grievance of the petitioner if any substance is found therein.
