This is a petition filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 120 dated 12.9.2016 under Sections 323, 324, 307, 458, 148 and 149 of the Indian Penal Code registered at Police Station Kharar, District Mohali.
