Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.0363 dated 22.07.2018 under Sections 307, 323, 336, 506, 148, 149 IPC and Section 25 Arms Act registered at Police Station Focal Point, Ludhiana.

On 07.08.2018, this Court issued notice to the State after noting the contention raised on behalf of the petitioner that though the injury attributed to the petitioner is that he had caused *kirch* blow on the middle finger of right hand of Gurpreet Singh, but there is no medical evidence to support the said injury.

Learned State counsel has produced a photocopy of the statement of Surjit Singh, who is injured in the case and said Surjit Singh

has suffered a statement to the effect that it is the petitioner who has given *kirch* blow on the head of Surjit Singh.

In view thereof, no case for grant of anticipatory bail is made out.

Dismissed.
