This is a petition under Section 439 Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.169 dated 12.9.2014 under Sections 15 and 27-A of Narcotic Drugs & Pscyhotropic Substance Act registered at Police Station Baragudha, District Sirsa.

It is a case of commercial quantity of contraband.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that the recovery has been effected from three persons and if divided among them, it will come to non-commercial quantity but to the mind of this Court, it is a case of commercial quantity of contraband. As such, no case such is made out for grant of regular bail.

Dismissed. However, trial Court is directed to expedite the trial and dispose of the same as early as possible preferably within a period of six months from the date already fixed therein.
