The present petition has been filed under Section 439 Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail to petitioner-Navneet Kaur, in case FIR No.57 dated 26.05.2018 registered for the offence punishable under Section 306/34 of the Indian Penal Code (for short 'IPC') at Police Station Jaito, District Faridkot.

Heard.

It has been submitted that husband of the petitioner had died leaving behind her as well as their minor kid.

The allegations against the petitioner are that petitioner along with her relatives have quarreled with the deceased-husband. She is in custody since 28th May, 2018. Challan has already been submitted.

Without expressing any opinion on merits of the case and keeping in view the fact that conclusion of trial will take considerably long time, the present petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on

regular bail on furnishing bail bond and surety bond to the satisfaction of trial Court/Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, concerned subject to following terms:-

- (a) The petitioner shall comply with the conditions mentioned in Section 437(3) Cr.P.C.
- (b) In the event of her absence on any date of hearing, the benefit of bail allowed to the petitioner shall stand withdrawn. The trial court shall be competent to cancel her bail bond and surety bond and proceed to procure her presence in accordance with law. In that eventuality the petitioner shall have to apply for bail afresh.
- (c) She shall not leave the country without the previous permission of the court.
