Petitioners-Virpal Kaur and Kiranjit Kaur have filed this petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.85 dated 20.07.2018, registered at Police Station Jaiton, District Faridkot, under Sections 452, 323, 506 and 34 of Indian Penal Code.

Notice of motion was issued in this case.

Learned State counsel put in appearance on behalf of the respondent-State and contested this petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioners as well as learned State counsel and have gone through the record.

From the record, I find that the present petitioners are stated to have given simple injuries to the complainant with dandas. They are not required for custodial interrogation. No useful purpose will be served by sending the petitioners to custody.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts of the case in minute details and without

expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, I find merit in this petition and the same is allowed. It is ordered that in the event of arrest, the petitioners be released on interim bail subject to their furnishing personal bonds and surety to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer subject to the condition that the petitioners shall join the investigation as and when called upon by the police and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
