Petitioner seeks concession of regular bail pending trial in FIR No. 87 dated 18.05.2017, under Sections 21/22/25/61/85 of Narcotic Durgs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 registered at Police Station City Moga.

As per prosecution version recovery effected from the petitioner was of 500 intoxicant tablets and 3 grams of heroin.

As per FSL report, the alleged recovery effected was of 102 grams of intoxicant powder and was found to be containing Alprazolam.

Petitioner was arrested on 18.05.2017.

Investigation in the case is complete, challan has been

presented and charges have been framed.

The trial, as such, is at the very initial stage and would take time to conclude.

Alleged recovery effected from the petitioner would be construed as marginally over and above the commercial quantity. Petitioner is not stated to be involved in any other case under the NDPS Act.

In the totality of the circumstances and without making any observation on merits present petition is allowed.

Petitioner be enlarged on bail subject to the satisfaction of the trial Court/ Duty Magistrate concerned.

Petition disposed of.
