GURVINDER SINGH GILL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioners seek quashing of FIR No.118 dated 05.07.2013 under Sections 458, 324, 323, 148, 149 of Indian Penal Code, 1860, Police Station Talwandi Sabo, District Bathinda and proceedings emanating therefrom on the basis of a compromise having been effected between the parties.

Vide order dated 06.09.2017, the parties had been directed to

appear before the Illaqa Magistrate so as to get the statements recorded with regard to the genuineness of the compromise.

Report of learned Sub-Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Talwandi Sabo received to the effect that apart from statements of the petitioners, statements of Lovedeep Singh, Amarjit Kaur, Raj pal Kaur, Jasvir Kaur and Amritpal Singh have been recorded. It may here be mentioned that aforesaid Lovedeep Singh, Amarjit Kaur, Raj Pal Kaur, Jasvir Kaur are all legal heirs of deceased complainant-Gurditta Singh while Amritpal is an injured and that the aforesaid persons have categorically stated that the matter has been compromised with the accused-petitioners and that they have no objection in case, the FIR is quashed. It has specifically been opined by Sub-Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Talwandi Sabo that the compromise has been effected voluntarily without there being any undue influence or coercion.

In view of the aforesaid compromise and bearing in mind the law laid down by Full Bench of this Court in 2007(3) RCR (Crl.) 1052 Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab, the petition is allowed and FIR No.118 dated 05.07.2013 under Sections 458, 324, 323, 148, 149 of Indian Penal Code, 1860, Police Station Talwandi Sabo, District Bathinda and all the consequent proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed qua the petitioners.
