In the present petition, petitioners' grievance is two fold namely holding of impartial investigation and extending security of life and liberty. In this regard, detailed inquiry had been conducted. Thereafter, report had been prepared vide Annexures R1/T and R2/T. Perusal of the same it is evident that dispute is pending consideration before the civil Court. Therefore, question of interference by the police is impermissible insofar as extending security to the petitioners relating to threatening by the contesting respondent is concerned. In the report it is clearly stated that there is no threat or danger to the petitioners' life. At the same time, SHO has been directed to conduct security proceedings. In view of these facts and circumstances, grievance of the petitioners do not survive for consideration.

Accordingly, petition stands disposed of.
