The present petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.48 dated 20.07.2018 registered under Sections 323, 452, 506 and 34 of the Indian Penal Code at Police Station Behram, District S.B.S. Nagar.

On 07.06.2018, the following order was passed by this

Court:-

“ Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he has instructions to submit that the matter has been compromised with the complainant party. Learned State counsel submits that the investigating officer has no information about the compromise but will verify the same.

List on 29.11.2018.

In the meanwhile, petitioner is directed to surrender before the police and join investigation within two weeks. In the event of his arrest being required, he shall be released on interim bail till the next date, subject to his furnishing bonds to the satisfaction of Arresting Officer. However, he shall abide by the terms and conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2)(i) to (iv) Cr.P.C. failing which he shall lose the benefit of interim bail allowed to him.”

It is contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that in terms of the order dated 07.09.2018, the petitioner has joined investigation and his custodial interrogation is no longer required.

On instructions from ASI Resham Lal, the above factual position is duly acknowledged by learned State counsel and stated that the custodial interrogation of the petitioner is no longer required.

In view of the above, the order dated 07.09.2018 is made absolute subject to the provisions of Section 438(2) Cr. P.C.

Petition stands disposed off.
