Prayer in this petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is for grant of bail pending trial in case FIR No. 239 dated 05.07.2018 under Sections 392, 379-B of IPC, registered at Police Station Badhra, District Charkhi Dadri.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the allegations against the petitioner are concocted ones. It is further contended that in any case, the alleged material already stands recovered by the police. The petitioner is in custody since 14.07.2018. Challan in this case has already been filed. It is further contended that the trial is likely to take long time and the petitioner is not required for any investigation purposes.

On the other hand, learned State counsel submits that there are four more cases against the petitioner.

In reply, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner is on bail in all those cases.

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In view of the above submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioner, but without commenting any further on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on bail pending trial subject to his furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Chief Judicial Magistrate/Illaqa Magistrate, concerned.
