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**RAMENDRA JAIN, J. (ORAL)**

1. Through this petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C., prayer has been made for quashing FIR No. 199 dated 17.09.2017 under Sections 323, 341, 506, 34 of the IPC registered at Police Station Goraya District Jalandhar (Annexure P-1) and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of compromise (Annexure P-2) effected between the parties.

2. Vide orders dated 07.08.2018, the parties were directed to appear before the trial Court to get their statements recorded for compromise with a direction to the trial Court, to furnish a report qua veracity of the compromise.

3. Consequently, petitioner and respondent No. 2 appeared before the Additional District and Sessions Judge, Jalandhar and got recorded their statements qua compromise on 06.09.2018. Report from the Additional

District and Sessions Judge, Jalandhar, vide letter No. 211 dated 06.09.2018, duly forwarded by learned District and Sessions Judge, Jalandhar, vide Endst. No. 2252/G/JRK, Dated 07.09.2018, has been received. According to the report of the Additional District and Sessions Judge, Jalandhar, the compromise is genuine and it is voluntarily effected between the parties with their free consent and without any pressure, threat, coercion or undue influence from any side.

4. As per the report of the trial Court, the compromise has been arrived at between the petitioner and respondent No. 2 only. Hence, the present FIR shall remain in force against respondent No. 3-accused.

5. In view of the totality of the facts and circumstances and considering the fact that the compromise will bring peace and harmony in relations between the parties, this petition is allowed and the aforesaid FIR No. 199 dated 17.09.2017 under Sections 323, 341, 506, 34 of the IPC registered at Police Station Goraya District Jalandhar (Annexure P-1) and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, qua the petitioner only is quashed, subject to payment of costs of Rs. 10,000/-, out of which Rs. 4,000/- shall be deposited with the Bar Association of Punjab and Haryana, High Court, Rs. 1000/- with the Bar Council of Punjab and Haryana and Rs. 5,000/- with the High Court Legal Services Committee, within two weeks from today, failing which this petition shall be deemed to be dismissed.
