The petitioner seeks regular bail in case FIR No.71 dated 17.05.2018, registered at Police Station Barnala, District Barnala, under Sections 306 and 120-B IPC.

The allegations in the FIR are that Jaspal Singh son of Mehar Singh committed suicide on account of harassment by the family members of his wife.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is the brother in law of the deceased person and his role is identical to that of the mother in law and father in law, who have been granted anticipatory bail vide order dated 21.08.2018, passed by this Court in CRM-M-25754-2018 and CRM-M-27461-2018.

The aforementioned submission is not denied by the learned State counsel.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of this case, I deem it appropriate to allow this petition. Accordingly, the petition is allowed and the petitioner-Gurpreet Singh, is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court concerned.
