Prayer in this petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.378 dated 10.07.2018 registered under Sections 406, 420, 506 IPC at Police Station Gohana City, District Sonipat.

Vide order dated 10.08.2018, petitioner was granted ad-interim bail by this Court.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has produced schedule of repayment to the complainant i.e. M/s Krishan Lal Jitender Kumar in the connected petition i.e. **CRM-M-38062-2018** titled as ***Kamal Chug Versus State of Haryana and another***, and states that in view of the schedule, an amount of Rs.10 lakhs has already been transferred in the

Learned counsel for the respondent No.2-complainant does not dispute the transfer of amount in the account of complainant.

Learned State counsel states that pursuant to order dated 10.08.2018, petitioner has joined the investigation and her custodial interrogation is no more required at this stage.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

Considering the schedule of repayment so produced, and the petitioner having joined the investigation, the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 10.08.2018 is hereby made absolute.

Accordingly, present petition is allowed.

However, if required, the petitioner shall continue to join investigation as and when required to do so and shall abide by the terms and conditions, as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
