By way of filing this petition, the petitioners seek quashing of FIR No.150 dated 20.7.2014 registered at Police Station Adampur, District Jalandhar City under Sections 452, 324, 323, 427, 506, 148 and 149 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 and all consequential proceedings emanating therefrom on the basis of a compromise having been effected between the parties.

Vide order dated 8.8.2018, the parties had been directed to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate/trial Court so as to get their statements recorded qua the factum of compromise.

Report of learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Jalandhar has been received to the effect that the statements of the petitioners/accused Surinder Kumar @ Shindri, Sukhjinder Singh, Kamaljit Singh and Kamaljit Kumar as well as of complainant Raj Kumar have been recorded to the effect

that they have compromised the matter amongst themselves and they have no objection in case the FIR is quashed.

It has specifically been opined by learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Jalandhar that the parties have entered into compromise voluntarily and without there being any pressure, coercion or undue influence.

In view of the aforesaid compromise and bearing in mind the law laid down by Full Bench of this Court in 2007(3) RCR (Crl.) 1052 Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab, the petition is allowed and FIR No.150 dated 20.7.2014 registered at Police Station Adampur, District Jalandhar City under Sections 452, 324, 323, 427, 506, 148 and 149 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 and all the consequent proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed qua the petitioners.
