Pursuant to the order dated 02.11.2017, status report by way of an affidavit of Bhupinder Singh, PPS, Deputy Supdt. of Police, Sub-Division Malout, District Sri Muktsar Sahib, has been placed on record. According to this report, FIR No. 79 dated 20.10.2015, was registered at Police Station Malout Sadar, under Sections 324, 34 IPC against respondent Nos.5 and 6. A cross case was registered vide *Rapat* No. 17 dated 15.10.2015, against the petitioner and Jagpal Singh son of Sadhu Singh. After investigation, it has been found that the land of both the parties are adjoining each other. On 30.09.2015, respondent Nos. 5 and 6 were irrigating the land by taking water from the water course with the help of motor and this was objected to by the petitioner resulting in minor altercation and scuffle. Neither of the parties received any injury with any sharp weapon. The injury to the small finger of the petitioner, is either self-inflicted or through friendly hands.

2. A cancellation report was approved by the SSP, Sri Muktsar Sahib on 26.10.2016 and the same is stated to have been presented before the Illaqa Magistrate on 22.09.2017. Both parties have been sent notices for appearance before the said Court.

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous. The parties, if so advised, may file objection/protest petition before the trial Court/Illaqa Magistrate.
