The petitioners seek quashing of FIR No.110 dated 1.6.2017, under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B IPC, Police Station City, Tarn Taran which was lodged at the instance of Surjit Kaur wife of Jaswinder Singh.

The allegations, in nutshell are that mother of Jaswinder Singh namely Piar Kaur had suffered a statement during proceedings of a civil suit regarding 31 kanals of land in favour of her son Jaswinder Singh. However, it is alleged that subsequently Piar Kaur sold the said land in favour of her other son Balwinder Singh by mentioning therein a pedigree table showing that Jaswinder Singh has since expired whereas Jaswinder Singh was alive.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that in fact the said mistake in pedigree table regarding death of Jaswinder Singh had

mentioned due to inadvertance and the same was corrected subsequently shortly after execution of the sale deed and in fact 3 months prior to lodging of the present FIR. The learned counsel has submitted that he had already submitted a representation to the police highlighting the aforesaid correct facts but no action had been taken thereupon so far.

Having heard the learned counsel for the petitioners, the petition is disposed of with a direction to Senior Superintendent of Police, Tarn Taran to look into the matter and to decide the representation (Annexure P-3) expeditiously, preferably within a period of 3 months from today.

A copy of representation (Annexure P-3) along with copy of this order be sent to Senior Superintendent of Police, Tarn Taran to enable him to do the needful expeditiously.
