ANITA CHAUDHRY, J

Petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.0160 dated 16.06.2018, registered under Sections 363 & 366-A IPC at Police Station Division No.6, Ludhiana.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is in custody since 24.06.2018 and challan has been presented. Counsel further states that couple have got married and the prosecutrix is now residing with her parents. Counsel refers to the marriage certificate (Annexure P-3) and also to the photographs.

Recovery has been effected. Investigation is over. Challan has already been presented.

The trial would take time. Without commenting anything on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on her furnishing surety and adequate bail bonds to the satisfaction of the Illaqa Magistrate/Duty Magistrate with a condition that the petitioner would not approach the prosecutrix or tamper with the evidence.
