Petitioner Davinder Singh has filed this petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.57 dated 19.04.2018, registered at Police Station Urban Estate, District Patiala, under Sections 419, 420, 465, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B of IPC and Section 82 of the Registration Act, 1977.

Notice of motion was issued.

Learned State counsel appeared and contested the instant petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and gone through the record.

The allegation against the present petitioner is that he had got prepared forged power of attorney, on the basis of which, he executed forged sale deed by impersonation of about 372 sq. yards, which was the property of the complainants.

Challan has already been presented before the trial Court and

charges have already been framed. The petitioner has been in custody since

15.05.2018. He is not required for any investigation or interrogation purposes as he is in judicial custody. He is only to face the trial. The trial of the case will take long time. No useful purpose will be served by keeping the petitioner in custody till the final disposal of the case.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts in minute detail and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this criminal miscellaneous petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds in the sum of ₹50,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
