Notice to respondent could not be issued as appellant failed to comply with order dated 15.3.2018 despite grant of additional opportunity to do the needful. A relevant extract from order dated 15.3.2018, reads as follows:-

“Notice to respondent could not be issued as counsel for the appellant did not comply with order dated 17.8.2017 despite expiry of more than six months.

In the interest of justice, one more opportunity is allowed to the appellant to comply with aforesaid order, failing which it may be of adverse consequences. On necessary compliance within fifteen days, notice to the respondent, returnable for 17.5.2018.”

In the given circumstances, there is no option with the court except to dismiss the appeal for necessary compliance.
