The present petition has been filed under Section 439 Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.119 dated 1.9.2015 registered for the offences punishable under Sections 399/402/119/473 of the Indian Penal Code and 25/54/59 of the Arms Act at Police Station Kharar, District SAS Nagar.

Heard.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that name of the petitioner has come forward solely on the basis of disclosure statement. He is in custody since 16.1.2016. He is a Constable in the Boarder Security Force.

Without expressing any opinion on merits of the case and

keeping in view the fact that conclusion of trial will take considerably long time, the present petition is allowed. Petitioner Prem Singh is ordered to be released on regular bail on furnishing bail bond and surety bond to the satisfaction of trial Court/Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, S.A.S. Nagar, subject to the following terms:-

- (a) The petitioner shall comply with the conditions mentioned in Section 437(3) Cr.P.C.
- (b) In the event of his absence on any date of hearing, the benefit of bail allowed to the petitioner shall stand withdrawn. The trial Court shall be competent to cancel his bail bond and surety bond and proceed to procure his presence in accordance with law. In that eventuality the petitioner shall have to apply for bail afresh.
- (c) He shall not leave the country without the previous permission of the Court.
