The instant petition has been filed for quashing of FIR No.204 dated 09.07.2018, under Sections 354, 452, 420, 506, 120-B of Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station City Rajpura, District Patiala.

Learned counsel for the petitioners herein contends that there was a dispute that has arisen between the parties, which was compromised and now the similar allegations have been raised by the complainant. It is argued that the allegations are patently false, as would be evident from the fact that even the sister, who is residing in Spain, has been roped in. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that representations dated 09.07.2018 and 11.07.2018 (Annexures P-2 and P-5 respectively) have already been moved in this regard, but no action has been taken. Therefore, at the present moment, learned counsel for the petitioners limits his prayer

to the extent that the said representations should be decided expeditiously.

Notice of motion.

At this stage, on the asking of the court Ms. Rajni Gupta, Senior DAG Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and submits that the respondent-State will look into the matter and will decide the representations of the petitioners within a period of six weeks, on receipt of certified copy of this order. Let sufficient number of copies of the paper book be supplied to her during the course of the day, failing which no action is called for.

In view of the above, I dispose of the instant petition by directing the respondent-State to decide the representations dated 09.07.2018 and 11.07.2018 (Annexures P-2 and P-5 respectively) of the petitioners within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order, in accordance with law. While disposing of this petition, liberty is given to the petitioners herein to approach this court afresh, in case, they desire so.

The petition stands disposed of in the above-said terms.
