GURVINDER SINGH GILL, J. (Oral)

This order shall dispose of above-mentioned two petitions filed on behalf of petitioner(s) Vijay and Karan, seeking anticipatory bail in respect of offence under Section 307 IPC, which has been added later on in FIR No.85, dated 16.9.2017, under Sections 323, 324 and 34 IPC, Police Station Khanauri, Sangrur.

The FIR in question had initially been registered in the year September 2017 for offences under Section 323 and 324 IPC wherein the petitioner(s) had been released on bail.

However, subsequently on 23.5.2018, the police had added an offence under Section 307 IPC after having obtained an opinion of the Doctor.

Pursuant to directions issued by this Court, the petitioner(s) Vijay and Karan have joined investigation as has been informed by learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Sawtantarpal Singh.

Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case and also that ever since the petitioner(s) were granted bail initially in September 2017, petitioner(s) have not misused the concession of bail and have joined the investigation, the petitions are hereby accepted and interim directions issued vide order dated 08.08.2018 passed in CRM-M-34014-2018 and order dated 01.10.2018 passed in CRM-M-41764-2018 are made absolute subject to the condition that the petitioner(s) would appear before Investigating Officer as and when called upon to do so and cooperate with the investigation.
