In the present petition, petitioner seeks setting aside of order dated 01.08.2018 vide which anticipatory bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 24.04.2018 has been cancelled in FIR No.21 dated 08.01.2018 under Sections 120-B, 420, 467, 468, 471, 506 IPC registered at Police Station Karnal City, Karnal.

2. This Court vide order dated 08.08.2018 had directed the petitioner to join investigation and in the event of his arrest, he was ordered to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

3. Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Sajjan Singh states that in pursuance to the order dated 08.08.2018 petitioner has joined investigation. Petitioner is not required for custodial interrogation.

4. In view of these factual aspect and circumstances, without expressing any opinion on the merits of case, the order dated 08.08.2018, granting ad-interim bail to the petitioner, is hereby made absolute. However, the petitioners shall abide by the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

5. However, the petitioner shall not in any way indulge in any criminal activities and he shall also not influence the witnesses or other wise interfere with the fair trial. Petitioner cannot leave the country without prior permission of Chief Judicial Magistrate/Illaqa Magistrate, Karnal. He shall also surrender his passport to the Investigating Officer. In case he do not hold passport, he will furnish affidavit to that effect.

6. Accordingly, order dated 24.04.2018 set aside and petition stands allowed.
