This is a petition that has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No.119 dated 31.07.2014 registered under Sections 494, 498-A of Indian Penal Code at Police Station Women Cell, District Patiala and all subsequent proceedings on the basis of compromise.

By an order dated 23.09.2016, the parties were directed to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate and get their statements recorded regarding validity of the compromise arrived at between the parties. Since the statements were not recorded, counsel for the petitioner requested for one more opportunity to comply with the said order. By an order dated 07.03.2017, one more opportunity was granted to the parties to comply with the order dated 23.09.2016 and get their statements recorded. Again another opportunity was given on 21.04.2017 for the purpose to appear before the

Illaq Magistrate to get their statements recorded. Subsequently, by an order dated 02.06.2017 another opportunity was given to the parties to comply with the previous order. Thereafter, no one put in appearance on behalf of the petitioner. On 18.08.2017, the matter was adjourned in the interest of justice for 13.10.2017. Again the matter was taken up on 15.11.2017, on which date there was no appearance on behalf of the petitioner. Even today, no one has put in appearance on behalf of the petitioner.

In view of the facts narrated above, the interest of justice has already been extended to its farthest possible extent, as such, there is no ground made out to adjourn the matter any further.

Dismissed for want of prosecution.
