Prayer in this petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.40 dated 23.05.2018 registered under Sections 406, 420 IPC at Police Station City Banga, District Shaheed Bhagat Singh Nagar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to the order dated 09.08.2018 passed by this Court, petitioner has joined the investigation. He further states that the matter was sent to Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court and accordingly, parties appeared there and a settlement/compromise dated 09.10.2018 has entered into between the parties.

Mr. Bikramjit Singh Randhawa, Advocate, has put in appearance on behalf of complainant-respondent No.2 and filed his

vakalatnama in court today, which is taken on record. He does not dispute the compromise, however, states that the petitioner should pay the outstanding amount in terms of the compromise.

Learned counsel for the petitioner also does not dispute the compromise and undertakes to act on the said compromise.

On the other hand, learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Tarsem Singh, states that the petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is no more required at this stage.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

Since the petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is no more required, present petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 09.08.2018 is made absolute. The parties shall honour the compromise in letter and spirit.

However, if required, the petitioner shall continue to join investigation as and when required to do so and shall abide by the terms and conditions, as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
