The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.61 dated 5.5.2018 registered for the offences punishable under Sections 420, 120-B of Indian Penal Code at Police Station Beas, District Amritsar (Rural).

Heard.

Counsel for the petitioner has placed on record affidavit of Sukhwinder Hans. A perusal of the same transpires that the first page appears to be of affidavit but the second page of the same appears to be the remainder page of the compromise.

The investigating officer who is present in Court submits that he has a talk with the complainant that no compromise has been effected between the parties.

The allegations leveled against the petitioner are serious in nature. He duped the complainant of a sum of Rs. 33 lacs.

Counsel for the petitioner asserts that the petitioner was a taxi driver and he has no concern with the travel agency

Keeping in view the allegations leveled against the petitioner, no case is made out for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

Dismissed.
