The application is allowed as prayed for subject to all just exceptions. Complainant-Roop Kumar is impleaded as respondent No.2. Amended memo of parties is ordered to be taken on record at an appropriate place.

Main case

In the instant petition, petitioner has sought for regular bail under the provision of Section 439 Cr.P.C in case FIR No.150 dated 18.05.2018 registered under Sections 306, 34 IPC at Police Station Jind Sadar, District Jind.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that petitioner is in custody since 8.4.2018. Perusal of suicide note of the deceased, it is evident that deceased has implicated only Ajmer, Kala and Rajbir. Whereas the complainant made allegation against the petitioner to the extent that one of the cause of committing suicide by the deceased is petitioner to the extent that he has made number of calls to the deceased.

3. Heard the learned counsel for the parties.
4. Having regard to the fact that name of the petitioner is not reflected in the suicide note of the deceased (Annexure P-1) and he is in custody since 8.4.2018, without commenting on the merit of the case, petitioner-Ram @ Ram Chander is ordered to be released on bail to the satisfaction of concerned Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate.
5. However, the petitioner shall not in any way indulge in any criminal activities and he shall also not influence the witnesses or otherwise interfere with the fair trial.
6. Petition is allowed accordingly.
