Pursuant to the order dated 22.01.2018, the petitioner and the Investigating Officer are stated to have appeared before the learned Area Magistrate, Bhatinda, and thereafter the petitioner having joined investigation he has been admitted to interim bail.

It having been shown in the FIR that the petitioner escaped from the spot (his house), which a police party consisting of four persons is stated to have raided upon an information received, and thereafter having recovered 90 tablets of Alprazolam and 260 tablets Triesr (Tramadol), it is atleast prima facie difficult to accept that a person would escape from his house with a police party of four persons being present there.

However, that is a matter that would be gone into in further investigation and trial when it comes to that stage.

Presently, the petitioner having joined investigation and the recovery stated to have been effected from the house of the petitioner in any

case having been so effected, and no other case stated to have been registered against him as per instructions of learned State counsel from the person present in Court to assist him, the order dated 10.01.2018, is made absolute.
