ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioners are seeking quashing of FIR No.68 dated 24.07.2016 under Sections 342/452/454/380/506/447/448/148/149 IPC registered at Police Station Islamabad, District Amritsar (Annexure P-1), along with all consequential proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of compromise (Annexure P-2) arrived at between the parties.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that FIR is an outcome of a dispute between the neighbours which has now been resolved and the matter has been compromised.

A co-ordinate Bench of this Court by the order dated 24.09.2016, had directed the parties to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate/trial Court for recording their statements with regard to

veracity of the compromise. The Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Amritsar, has sent reports dated 24.10.2016 and 19.05.2018 respectively, wherein it is stated that in pursuance to the order of this Court, statements of the parties were recorded. As per the statements, compromise has been effected without any fear or undue influence.

The FIR is an outcome of a dispute between the neighbours which has now been resolved and the matter has been compromised.

In view of the law laid down in "**Narinder Singh Vs. State of Punjab**" **2014 (6) SCC 466**, no useful purpose will be served by continuing the criminal proceedings. Therefore, the petition is allowed and FIR No.68 dated 24.07.2016 under Sections 342/452/454/380/506/447/448/148/149 IPC registered at Police Station Islamabad, District Amritsar and all consequential proceedings arising therefrom, are hereby quashed qua the petitioners only.
