The instant petition has been filed under Section 482 of Cr.P.C. seeking a direction to the official respondents to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner and her family members at the hands of the private respondents.

It is contended that despite the representation dated 16.07.2018 (Annexure P-1) moved to the Superintendent of Police, Kaithal, no action has been taken in the matter. Learned counsel for the petitioner urges that the representation dated 16.07.2018 (Annexure P-1) should be decided expeditiously.

Notice of motion to the official respondents.

At this stage, on the asking of the court, Ms. Gaganpreet Kaur, AAG Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the official respondents and

submits that official respondents will look into the matter and will decide the representation of the petitioner within a period of eight weeks, on receipt of certified copy of this order. Let sufficient number of copies of the paper book be supplied to her during the course of the day, failing which no action is called for.

In view of the above, I dispose of the instant petition by directing the official respondents to decide the representation dated 16.07.2018 (Annexure P-1) of the petitioner within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order, in accordance with law.

The petition stands disposed of in the above-said terms.
