Prayer in this petition is for grant of regular bail in FIR No. 461 dated 15.6.2017 under Section 381 IPC registered at Police Station Central District, Faridabad.

Counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the statement of the complainant has already been recorded by the trial Court. It is further submitted that the petitioner was working as a domestic servant and she has four minor children and there is no other person to look after them. It is also stated that the petitioner is a lady aged about 40 years and she is on bail in another FIR. It is also submitted that co-accused of the petitioner namely Ranjit Singh has already been released on bail by the trial court on 26.6.2017 and the petitioner is in custody since 18.6.2017.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Yashpal Singh has not disputed the factual position. However, has opposed the prayer for grant of bail on the ground that the petitioner is involved in other cases as

well.

Without commenting anything on the merits of the case and

considering the fact that the petitioner is in judicial custody since 18.6.2017; she has four minor children; co-accused of the petitioner has already been released on bail; that the statement of the complainant has already been granted, the petitioner is directed to be released on bail subject to her furnishing bail bond/surety bond to the satisfaction of the trial court/Illaqa Magistrate.

The Criminal Misc. application stands disposed of.
