Learned State counsel submits that as per the information furnished by the police, the petitioner is facing charges in two criminal cases bearing FIR No.338 dated 13.9.2018 under Sections 406, 420, 465, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B IPC, Police Station Zirakpur and FIR No. 68 dated 4.5.2018 under Sections 419, 420, 465, 467, 468, 471, 120-B IPC, Police Station SBS Nagar, Ludhiana and that the petitioner is not required in any other criminal case/complaint at this stage.

In the light of this stand of the State, the present petition stands disposed off with the directions to the official respondents to ensure that in case the petitioner is required for the purpose of investigation in any of the criminal case/complaint, she shall be given

seven days prior notice so as to enable her to have legal recourse in accordance with law.

With these observations, the present petition stands disposed off.
