In this petition, the petitioner seeks his release on regular bail in F.I.R. No.10, dated 23.01.2017, under Sections 147/148/149/323/324/452/506 of the Indian Penal Code (Charge framed under Sections 143/148/307/323/460 read with Section 149 of the Indian Penal Code), registered at Police Station Loharu, District Bhiwani.

2. The petitioner was arrested on 10.02.2017.

3. It further transpires that as of now only two of the twenty five charge-sheeted challaned witnesses have been examined.

4. In this view of the matter, at this stage further indefinite detention of the petitioner is not justified.
