1. In the instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C., prayer has been made for direction to respondents No. 2 and 4 to conclude the inquiry expeditiously in complaint dated 11.04.2018 bearing No.1788/COP/14/4/2018/ACP/South (Annexure P-1) pending before respondent No. 4 and to register FIR against the accused persons mentioned therein.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the purpose of the instant petition would be achieved, at this stage, if respondents No. 2 and 4 are directed to conclude the inquiry in complaint dated 11.04.2018 which is pending before respondent No. 4 and also to take appropriate legal action on it expeditiously

3. In view of the above, respondent No. 2-Commissioner of Police, Amritsar, is directed to look into the matter and conclude the inquiry (Annexure P-1) on the complaint dated 11.04.2018, moved by the petitioner, in accordance with law, by passing a speaking order and after affording an opportunity of hearing to him, within a period of one month from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

4. The instant petition stands disposed of, accordingly.
