The status report by way of affidavit of Parampal Singh, PPS, Senior Superintendent of Police, District Amritsar has been filed. Same is taken on record. Copy has been supplied.

This petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No. 117 dated 03.12.2017, registered under Sections 323, 324, 307, 325, 34 IPC and Sections 25 and 27 of the Arms Act (Sections 307, 325 IPC and Sections 25 and 27 of the Arms Act added lateron) at Police Station Bhindi Saidan, Amritsar Rural.

The allegation against the petitioner is that he alongwith his associates caused injuries to the victim.

Initially, a charge sheet was submitted against two co-accused namely Daljit Singh and Ninder Singh, who after conclusion of trial have been acquitted on the ground that the injured eye witness had stated that some unknown person having muffled faces caused injuries to him.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Lakhwinder

Singh, has stated that the petitioner has joined the investigation; *datar* has already been recovered from him and he is no more required for custodial interrogation.

In the circumstances, without going into the merits of the case, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in the present case.

Resultantly, the interim order dated 20.08.2018 is made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands allowed.
