The petitioner seeks regular bail in case FIR No.127 dated 9.12.2017 registered at Police Station Moga Sadar under Section 22 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985.

As per the contents of the FIR, the petitioner was found in possession of 420 tablets of Alprazolam.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has been in custody since 9.12.2017 and the alleged recovery effected from her is of non-commercial quantity. The investigation is complete in this case and there is no other case pending against the petitioner and, thus, no useful purpose would be served by keeping the her in custody.

Learned State counsel does not contradict the factual submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioner.

In view of the above, I deem it appropriate to grant regular bail to the petitioner.

Accordingly, the petition is allowed and it is directed that the petitioner be released on regular bail on her furnishing bail and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court concerned.
